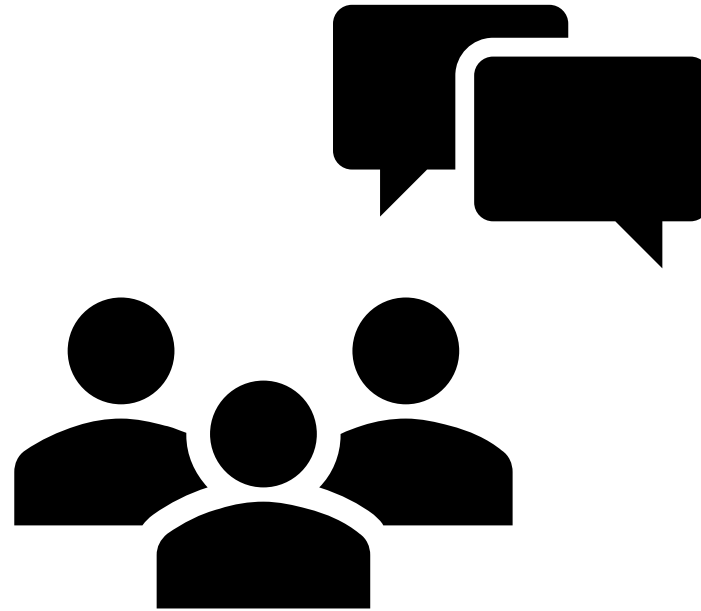

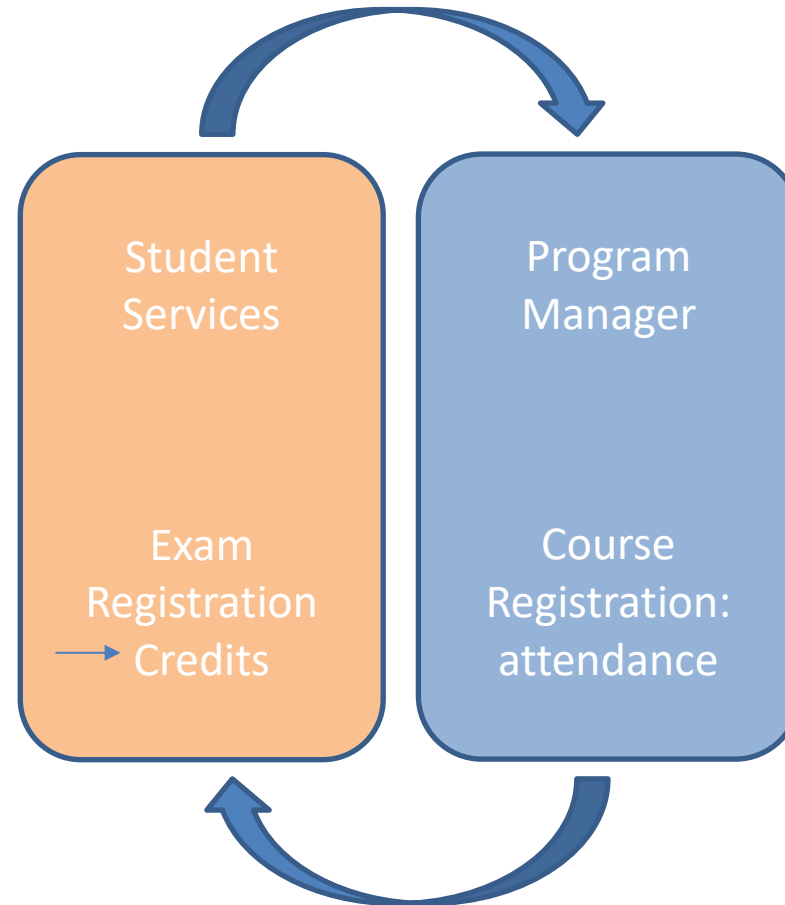

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Internship

- **Internship at a Research Institution** (6 weeks)
 - You work for at least 6 weeks (210 hours of work) at a social science research institution
 - Those may be academic or non-academic institutions
 - Focus on social sciences and empirical research
 - Internship Data Base
- **Summer School** (2 weeks)
 - Summer schools about empirically oriented social science research
 - A total of two weeks of attendance
 - List of accepted schools online



Also possible:

1 week Summer School + 3 weeks internship
Splitting the internship into 2x3 weeks
