

## Preparatory mathematics course for first year bachelor students (B.Sc. Psychology)

## Preparatory course

Many modules of the B.Sc. Psychology require knowledge of upper secondary school mathematics. This preliminary course is intended to close gaps in knowledge that have arisen due to the pandemic stresses in school life and to refresh the prerequisite upper secondary school subject matter. This is not a necessary part of the curriculum, but a targeted offer for those students in the first semester for whom the mathematics content of the upper school was a clear challenge or already dates back some time. Among other things, mathematical notation forms, basic arithmetic operations, the handling of functions and the intuition of differential and integral calculus are covered. The course will take place in the form of two parallel courses with three dates each between 09 and 16 September 2022.
