

Writing and revising term papers and theses

Academic Writing and Working, Academic- and Study Competence

The seminar consists of input sessions and sessions for free work. In the input sessions, there will be short, practice-oriented inputs on writing scientific work - the range of topics includes finding ideas and starting the writing process, tips and guiding questions on the structure of scientific work and its individual parts, scientific writing style and manuscript design, and revising one's own work from the beginning to the end of the project.

In addition to short inputs of about 30 minutes, there will also be space to work on your own project, partly in separate sessions. In these sessions, there will be the opportunity for individual counselling in case of difficulties and writer's block and for feedback on self-selected parts of the work. In addition, there will be several opportunities for detailed, guided peer feedback if desired.

Main topics:

- Topic planning and starting the project developing ideas, starting and planning the writing process.
- Structure of academic papers guiding questions and structuring individual sections
- Obtaining, creating and using (peer) feedback
- Scientific writing style APA recommendations, language and argument structure-
- Self Editing When and how to revise your work?
