

STATA-Sprechstunde (BA)

Wissenschaftliches Arbeiten

Every Friday morning during the Spring semester beginning at 10:15, we offer a Data Analysis with Stata consultation session on Zoom. These sessions are primarily directed towards students taking the Introduction to Data Analysis lecture and/or Übungen that normally take place in the second semester of the BA programme in Political Science. These sessions are led by MA student Lea Schultis. Each meeting will begin with Lea outlining a key technique used in data analysis, followed by a discussion of the statistical procedure and how to best accomplish this with the Stata statistical program. The session is then opened out to any questions that students might have on the topic of the week or any other issues relating to data analysis or Stata. The intention is to provide students who are learning applied data analysis for the first time with an open and relaxed forum to ask questions and discuss their uncertainties with a knowledgeable and helpful tutor who has been through the same courses in recent years. There is also an additional course-wide online forum available for students to post questions about Stata or data analysis, hosted on the ILIAS virtual learning environment.
