# Sample topics

Our Bachelor theses (BWL or Wi.-Päd.) are offered in three methodological formats ("flavors"):

- 1. **Literature review**: Summarizing, structuring, and critically reviewing the existing literature on a specific topic.
- 2. **Conceptual research**: Developing a conceptual framework or model to structure, elaborate, or answer a specific research question using pertinent theories.
- 3. **Exploratory empirical research**: Exploring a specific research phenomenon by using literature as well as primary (interviews) and secondary (e.g., databases, internet) data sources.
