Where is my mind? Attention, strategies, and their influence on (working) memory

Abstract:

A substantial and ever-growing area of research concerns how attention and maintenance strategies serve to keep accessible the most relevant contents of working memory. In this talk I will overview my recent research that has tried to get ever closer to what is in the "mind's eye" when it comes to maintaining visual and verbal information alike. I will also discuss the similarities and differences between spontaneous and instructed use of attention and strategies in working memory as well as their consequences for long-term episodic memory.
