The hands on information on the dos and don'ts of conducting research was very helpful. Moreover, the need to submit a draft proposal forced one to think more precisely about the topic. Also, getting feedback on the intended research from other students was useful to improve the planned work. The one-day workshop was a good experience: Besides discussing the own topic it was very inspiringly to get more familiar with the other's work. Especially the interdisciplinary approach should be continued.

- Regarding the review process: I agree with the suggestion to change the reviewer after the first review. - Sometimes it was too much to read.

Turning from talking about what to consider when doing research to how to publish was hard to follow. Since publishing and attending conferences feels quite far away for most of the class it was difficult to connect to this issue.
