You should be prepared to address the following questions: What makes that an interesting question? Is it an important question? What contributions would this question and the answers make to the scholarly literature? What strategies are there to answer your research questions(s)?

  your draft proposal as well as to me and everyone else in the workshop. The draft proposal is due 1 week
  before your field-specific Review and Feedback session.
- Prepare critical reviews of the draft proposals you are assigned to and present them in the Review and Feedback session
- Prepare a short presentation of your draft proposal and present it in our *Review and Feedback* session.
