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EINLEITUNG

Meine Hauptinteressen liegen in den Bereichen Migrationssoziologie und Übergänge im Jugendalter. In der Vergangenheit habe ich mich vor allem mit strukturellen Aspekten der Integration von Zuwanderern und dem Übergang von der Schule in den Beruf beschäftigt. Meine aktuelle Forschung erstreckt sich auf die kulturellen, sozialen und subjektiven Aspekte der Integration von Zuwanderern. Das Interesse an individuellen und kontextuellen Merkmalen zur Erklärung gesellschaftlicher Prozesse treibt meine Forschung voran, die sich auf fortschrittliche quantitative Methoden und überwiegend auf Umfragedaten stützt.
